Our Mission:

*Located in Pitman, NJ, **The Gallery on Broadway** is a cooperative of artist/members working together as a network of support and encouragement to help foster individual artistic growth in a variety of mediums and to provide a venue for exhibition and sale of current work.*

Benefits of becoming a member:

- Exhibition space

- Presence on Gallery website (Coming soon!)
- Opportunity to participate in Pitman's "4th Friday" events
- Only 10% commission on work sold
- Participation in a community of committed and creative individuals

Member Requirements:

- Gallery sit 1.5 days per month
- Contribute to "4th Friday" events (ie: food/drink for receptions)
- Attend monthly members' meetings
- Set up and maintain your own exhibit space by rotating and replacing artwork to keep a fresh exciting venue
- Have an email address and be comfortable communicating regularly
- Make a 6 month commitment by signing a preliminary contract and providing a security deposit equal to one month's rent.
- Pay monthly rent by the first of each month in accordance with your size space (Rents are approx. \$100-\$190 depending upon size and location)

To apply for Membership:

The goal of this cooperative is to represent high quality work in a variety of mediums. **At this time, there are a sufficient number of photographers in the group. Any photography applicants will be placed on a waiting list for future reference.** The Gallery encourages application by artists in diverse mediums such as fiber arts, glass, ceramics, painting, printing, mixed-media, etc. All applications by serious and dedicated individuals will be considered.
